The ladies’ day at Riverview went great with about 68 ladies in attendance and some of those were non-member first-time participants, so they also heard part of the gospel presented.

Expense wise, our lodging cost for 6 was only \$775, our flight cost was under \$8,000 and for food, gas, and class & ladies’ day material, we spent \$662.
