Church of Christ Pantry

The new pantry plan is in play.

- We will be removing all pantry items from the current location to the basement kitchen, by January 28, 2018
- There are drop boxes in both the old pantry area & in the new pantry area in the basement.
 - We currently have food boxed for 4 families. Each family will get 2 boxes of food. This includes canned goods, hygiene items, and any other item that is on our pantry list.
 - To make this easier for the Minister & Elders, each shelf has a box has a #1 or #2 on the lid. Work from the top down & that will keep the food current. I will rotate the food up to keep the oldest boxes on top. Each person, or family will be given a box #1 & box #2.
 - The boxes are labeled very clearly Church of Christ, with our address, and phone number. Each box also contains a can opener, a pocket bible, and our Church meeting hours.
 - We once again ask that the food be distributed by only the Minister or the Elders. This way there is no confusion. Please remember if you are a Church member and need assistance, go to one of these three people. It will be handled with the upmost confidence as all discussions with the Minister & Elders are.
 - Inventory as of January 21, 2018: there are 4 sets of food available to be given away. That cleaned out the pantry upstairs and left us very low on most products.
 - You will find a new reduced list of pantry needs, that has been created by 1st letter of last name. We broke it down in two groups. You DO NOT have to bring everything listed under your name. Bring what you can, 1 can or 2, or a case. We will take whatever you can afford.

Reminders: Please bring **ONLY** what is listed on the pantry list. We don't have room for additional items.

We have seen a great response to the new pantry. We thank each & every one of you. Hopefully you will like the improvements/changes to the Pantry.

If you have any question or issues or you would like me to show you how we are working the new pantry, you know where to find me.
