Cheryl McLain's niece has cancer of the spine.

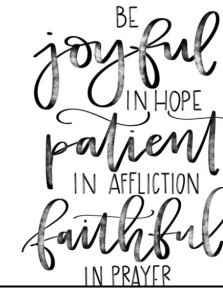
Debbie Burrow's mother Melba is not doing well. Debra has gone to care for her.
