New Worship Format for Sunday Evenings Starting October 3

One of the elders will start the worship time, then go systematically around the auditorium to each man. If you don’t feel comfortable, the turn will pass to the next man. This is a chance to share your faith before a loving and friendly audience, a chance to serve the congregation and practice leadership skills, and a chance to be an active part of our worship experience. If you have questions, don’t hesitate to talk to one of the elders.
